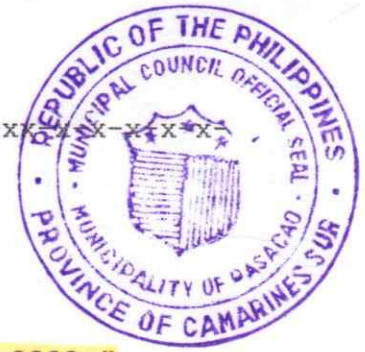

RESOLUTION NO. 56
S. 2002

INTRODUCED BY: HON. JOSE B. SACRAMENTO

" IN SUPPORT TO MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 03, S. 2002 "

WHEREAS, House Bill No. 1459 sponsored by then Honorable Congressman Juan F. Triviño of Camarines Sur paved the way for the creation of PASACAO SCHOOL OF FISHERIES at Barangay Caranan, Pasacao, Camarines Sur and was signed into law by then His Excellency President Diosdado Macapagal on June 22, 1963 under Republic Act. No. 3667;

WHEREAS, the said school was established to offer General Secondary Fishery Education Curriculum with emphasis on Fish Culture and Preservation, and in 1974 the Ministry of Education & Culture authorized the school of offering a 3-year Fishery Technical College Education Curriculum, with specialized on Fish Processing Technology, Inland and Marine Sciences;

WHEREAS, on March 3, 1995 the PASACAO SCHOOL OF FISHERIES was converted to CAMARINES SUR INSTITUTE OF FISHERIES AND MARINE SCIENCES (CASIFMAS) through House Bill No. 8227 sponsored by then Honorable Congressman Rolando R. Andaya, Sr. and signed into law by then His Excellency President Fidel V. Ramos under Republic Act. No. 7948.

WHEREAS, from its humble beginnings in 1963 to the present, the then PASACAO SCHOOL OF FISHERIES and the new CAMARINES SUR INSTITUTE OF FISHERIES AND MARINE SCIENCES has continued to provide quality education and training to the rural constituencies of the municipality, giving them ample opportunities for employment and livelihood;

WHEREAS, such achievements were the fruits of painstaking labor and legislative deligence & persistence in the Halls of Philippine Congress by no less than its proponent, the Late Honorable Congressman Juan F. Triviño of Camarines Sur and which the past and present generations of Pasaqueños were and still are highly grateful and indebted;

WHEREAS, in recognition of his exemplary public ^{service} to better the lives of Pasaqueños, this August Body unanimously decided to forever honor the Late Congressman Juan F. Triviño by naming after him the present High School Department of CASIFMAS which is now transferred to Dep Ed and shall now be known as JUAN F. TRIVIÑO MEMORIAL HIGH SCHOOL;

WHEREFORE, as it is hereby resolved to enact an ordinance to the effect.

**MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 03
S. 2002**

BE IT ORDAINED by this Honorable Sangguniang Bayan in an en banc session assembled that:

SECTION I. TITLE. This Ordinance shall otherwise be known as **AN ORDINANCE RENAMING THE CAMARINES SUR INSTITUTE OF FISHERIES AND MARINE SCIENCES (CASIFMAS) HIGH SCHOOL DEPARTMENT INTO JUAN F. TRIVIÑO MEMORIAL HIGH SCHOOL.**

SECTION II. LOCATION. This school shall be permanently located at Barangay Caranan, Pasacao, Camarines Sur.
