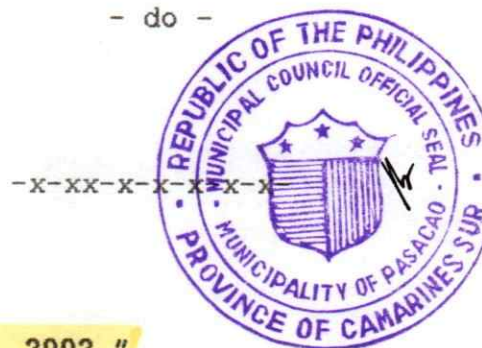

**RESOLUTION NO. 57  
S. 2002**

**" IN SUPPORT TO MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 04, S. 2002 "**

**WHEREAS**, the operation of three wheeled pedicabs (padyaks) or motorized pedicabs is being conducted in the municipality even without complying with all the necessary requirements prior to operation;

**WHEREAS**, it has been observed that many drivers of these pedicabs doesn't know traffic rules and regulations because they have not attended orientations or seminars;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to regulate the operation of these public utility vehicles in order to protect the safety of the riding public, pedestrians, and drivers of pedicabs (padyaks) or motorized pedicabs;

**WHEREFORE**, upon motion of the Honorable Chairman, Committee on Public Works and Utilities, Councilor Marilyn H. Sotto and unanimously seconded by the members present, be it -

**RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, to enact an ordinance for the purposes.

**MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 04, S. 2002**

**" AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF LOCALLY MADE THREE WHEELED PEDICAB, PADYAK OR MOTORIZED PEDICAB USED AS PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLE WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF PASACAO, CAMARINES SUR. "**

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Pasacao that:

**SECTION I. Title.** The ordinance shall be known as an Ordinance regulating the operation of locally made three wheeled pedicab (padyak) or motorized pedicab used as public utility vehicle within the jurisdiction of Pasacao, Camarines Sur.

**SECTION II.** The provisions of this ordinance shall control, enforce, direct and supervise the operation of pedicabs operated manually or motorized pedicabs used as local public utility vehicle and for private and business use.

**SECTION III. Definition of terms- Words and phrase used in this ordinance shall mean as follows:**

- a. **Locally made padyak or pedicab** - means a three-wheeled vehicle with a sidecar attached to bicycle used to transport passenger or cargoes either for private use or for hire.
- b. **Motorized pedicab** - shall mean a three-wheeled pedicab with a sidecar propelled by motor power but without transmission.
- c. **Driver** - shall mean the person who is in actual physical control to direct the or course of the vehicle.
- d. **Owner/Operator** - the actual legal owner who operates the three-wheeled pedicab in whose same such vehicle is duly registered.
- e. **Plate No.-** refers to the numbers and letters in the plate designated by the LGU for purposes of identifying the vehicle.

**SECTION IV. Permit to Operate and Qualifications of Applicants.**  
Permit to operate a pedicab as public utility may be granted upon application with the Office of the Mayor and or upon payment of the necessary fees to the Municipal Treasurer, provided that the applicant shall meet the following qualifications:

- 1. Filipino Citizen;
- 2. Resident of Pasacao for not less than 1 year at the time of his application as certified by the Barangay Captain where he resides;
- 3. Must not be less than 18 years of age;
- 4. Capable of maintaining the operation of the pedicab used as public vehicle and answering or shouldering liability that may arise in the course of the operation of the said vehicle.

**SECTION V. Registration** - Every unit of pedicab operated as public vehicle shall be registered with the Office of the Mayor. The owner/operator shall show the following requirements before the issuance of the permit to operate:

- a. Proof of ownership;
- b. Barangay clearance;
- c. Police clearance;

There shall be levied and collected fees per unit:

To be paid annually by the owner / operator to the Municipal Treasurer not later than the last working day of January of every year.

- No sidecar shall be registered without first registering the bicycle
- A Plate Number which measures \_\_\_\_\_ inches in height and \_\_\_\_\_ inches in width to be provided by the Municipal Treasurer Office shall be attached in front of the sidecar.
- A penalty equivalent to twenty five (25%) percent of the permit fee shall be charged per unit of late registration.

**SECTION VI. Traffic Orientation Seminar** - Drivers of the padyaks pedicabs shall undergo a one day seminar on traffic rules and regulation to be conducted by the LGU through PNP Police Station and a certificate of compliance shall be issued to qualified drivers before they could be allowed to drive the vehicle.

**SECTION VII. Identification Card** - all drivers of pedicab used as public vehicle within the municipality are required to display prominently in the vehicle then identification card which shall contain the following:

- a. Name of Driver;
- b. Address;
- c. Personal description;
- d. Signature of Barangay Captain where the driver resides, and signature of the Municipal Mayor.

Identification card issued under this ordinance is renewable annually on or before the last working day of February of every year and shall not be transferable.

It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator to hire, employ or let a person drive the unit without attending the traffic orientation seminar or without certificate of compliance.

Driver shall be presentable while driving the unit Sleeveless shirt or sando is strictly prohibited.

**SECTION VIII. Prohibitions.** The following are hereby prohibited.

- a. Driving of persons below 18 years of age;
- b. The owner/operator shall not allow any person below 18 years of age to drive the unit;
- c. Driving under the influence of liquor;
- d. Driving the unit during night time without reflectors or light or horns;
- e. Transferring of registration plate to another unit which such plate number was not issued.
- f. In no case shall a driver/operator in his exercise of his profession be abusive, arrogant, or discourteous to passenger and/or to pedestrian.
- g. Violating the Code of Conduct promulgated by the accredited association to which the violator is a member.
- h. Violating the required attire mandated for drivers.


**SECTION IX. Limitation of Passengers** - Every unit manually operated pedicab shall be allowed to carry three passengers only while the motorized pedicab shall be allowed of 6 passengers only.


**SECTION X. Required Accessories of Every Unit** - all units shall be equipped with the flag - mechanical brake, light, back reflector, horn or bell, side mirror. Without required accessories the vehicle shall not be used to convey passengers or cargo.




