MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 06
Series of 2002

"AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING GUIDELINES FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLES (PUVs) CENTRAL TERMINAL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PASACAO, CAMARINES SUR, TO BE KNOWN AS PASACAO PUBLIC CENTRAL TERMINAL"

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Pasacao, Camarines Sur that:

SECTION 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS. - All Public Utility Vehicles are required to make use of the terminal which shall be established for and by the Municipality of Pasacao.

SECTION 2. PURPOSE. - The purpose of this ordinance is to have a centralized terminal for PUVs in order to decongest traffic flow along the national road and protect commuting vehicles and pedestrians.

This will also improve the condition of transport services to minimize the duplication of facilities and allow for the sharing of costs and utilization of a less costly service.

SECTION 3. SCOPE. - This ordinance shall cover Public Utility Vehicles coming from or going to the Municipality of Pasacao, such as, but not limited to jeepneys, buses, and FilCab Express. Motorized trimobiles, tricycles and padyaks shall not be covered by the provisions on the operation of Central Terminal.

When used in this ordinance, PUVs shall refer to Public Utility Vehicles while Central Terminal shall refer to Pasacao Public Central Terminal.

SECTION 4. LOCATION. - The Central Terminal shall be located at any suitable site in the municipality as may be determined and identified by the Sangguniang Bayan, upon consultation with the Office of the Municipal Mayor. The site shall be acquired/ owned by the municipality.

SECTION 5. OPERATION. - The operations of the Central Terminal shall be administered by the Office of the Municipal Mayor under such rules, regulations or guidelines as may be promulgated for the purpose.


This provision shall not, however, be construed to prohibit the Municipal Mayor from letting the actual operations of the terminal to qualified individuals, persons or group should he deem it to be more economical and beneficial to the municipality; provided, that this will be subject to an open public bidding; provided, that the preference shall be given to existing cooperative (s); and provided, further, that any contract to that effect shall be subject to ratification by the Sangguniang Bayan.

SECTION 6. PROHIBITIONS. - The following acts are prohibited under this ordinance:

- a. Loading or unloading of PUVs within the Central Business District except at Central Terminal and other areas expressly provided in the traffic ordinance (Hereto attached as Annex "A");
- b. Construction or operation of a terminal by any operator or company apart from the Central Terminal, provided, however, that this prohibition shall not be construed to prohibit the operation of garages by PUV operators and companies.

SECTION 7. FACILITIES. - The Central Terminal shall be provided the following facilities, prior to its operation:

- a. A covered loading bay or departure shed with at least two (2) bays to accommodate at least one (1) Public Utility Jeepney; one (1) Bus; and one (1) Fil Cab Express.
- b. A covered loading platform for the waiting passengers with enough benches;
- c. Toilet facilities separate for men and women with adequate water supply;
- d. Separate passageways for incoming vehicles and the other one for departing vehicles;
- e. Sufficient area for garage and parking area for waiting vehicles;
- f. The whole frontage of the central terminal has to be paved with cement;
- g. Provide waste disposal facilities like trash containers, trash cans and the like to be placed in strategic area;
- h. Provide drainage system that is simple, easy to clean and maintain, and;



- i. Provide lighting facilities.

SECTION 8. EXISTING TERMINALS. - Existing terminals for PUVs with business permit for the current year shall be given 90 days to cease operation after notification by the Local Chief Executive, and upon passage of a resolution by the Sangguniang Bayan effecting the same.

SECTION 9. SPACE CAPACITY. - The space capacity measure of the Central Terminal shall be 18 sq. m. per PUV; 36 sq.m. per bus; and 18 sq. m. per Fil Cab Express.

SECTION 10. QUALIFICATION. - All dispatchers and porters within the Central Terminal must be:

- a. Filipino citizen and not less than 18 years old and resident of the municipality;
- b. of good moral character;
- c. not suffering from any physical or mental defects, contagious, or communicable diseases;
- d. with Police Clearance and Court Clearance issued by the PNP and the local court, respectively.

SECTION 11. REGISTRATION FEES. - Each dispatcher or porter shall register with the local government unit and a fee of P20.00 for every registration shall be levied and collected annually. The Municipal Treasurer shall provide the prescribed ID Card which shall be signed by the Municipal Mayor and the Local PNP Chief.

SECTION 12. WEARING OF UNIFORMS AND ID CARDS. - All dispatchers and porters shall be required to wear uniforms and their ID Cards during working hours within the vicinity of the terminal.

SECTION 13. PROVISIONS ON SANITATION. - No person shall operate or be employed in the Central Terminal without first securing a health certificate issued by the Municipal Health Officer. The health certificate shall bear the picture of the employee and shall be displayed visibly in the upper left portion of his / her uniform while working, and shall be renewable every year.

All personnel of the establishment shall, while working or on duty, observe good personal hygiene, wear appropriate uniform, and refrain from smoking while inside the terminal.

Ambulant food vendors may be allowed to operate within the premises of the central terminal, provided, they sell only pre-packed foods. All food establishments in the Central Terminal shall comply with the provisions of Chapter III (Food Establishments) of the Code on Sanitation of the Philippines (PD 856).

SECTION 14. REGULATION ON TERMINAL FEE. - To protect PUV operators / drivers from overcharging of terminal fee, the local government unit shall regulate the tariff, which shall be subject to public hearing. Overcharging of terminal fee shall be a ground for termination of contract, and cancellation of permit and licenses of the contractor / operator of the central terminal.

SECTION 15. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS. - The Office of the Municipal Mayor shall promulgate the implementing rules and regulations within 90 days upon enactment of this ordinance. The IRR shall be furnished the Sangguniang Bayan for information and record purposes.

SECTION 16. PENALTIES. - Any violation of any of the provisions herein prescribed shall be penalized with a fine of not more than P2,500.00 or imprisonment of not more than six months, or both at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 17. EFFECTIVITY. - This ordinance shall take effect upon approval of the Sangguniang Bayan.
